

End of Nursery Year Expectations

By the end of Nursery children are expected to be within the 40-60 months band in their development in order to be ready for Reception.

This includes all areas of learning; Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication & Language, Physical Development and the Specific Areas of Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

They are expected to be competent in many skills such as:

- Following instructions.
- Starting conversations and listening to others.
- Excepting the needs of others, sharing and following behavioral expectations.
- Using tools such as scissors, paint brushes and pencils effectively.
 - Using the toilet independently.
 - Writing letters that are beginning to be recognisable including writing their name.
 - Saying the first sounds of words e.g cccc; cat.
 - Able to recognise numbers and count objects 1-5.
